Ceramics in the City, now in its fourth year, will feature an exciting range of work by 50 ceramicists; some well-established names returning to the Geffrye and some emerging talents, all working in a variety of styles, sizes and techniques. Classic tableware, lamps and other domestic objects will be showcased alongside less functional, or purely decorative, pieces.

Visitors will have the opportunity not just to view and buy, but also to talk to the makers themselves in an informal setting. There will also be free demonstrations by selected ceramicists. Children tired of 'shopping' can join in a special craft activity which will run throughout the day on Saturday and Sunday.

Ceramics in the City has been organised by the Geffrye Museum and ceramicist Karen Bunting, and funded by the Geffrye Museum, Broadway Ceramics, Mazorca Projects and the European Regional Development Fund.
