Ceramics in the City, now in its fifth year, will feature an exciting range of work by 45 selected ceramicists in the light and airy setting of the Geffrye's dynamic modern extension. A variety of styles and techniques will be seen in work ranging from functional domestic objects such as tableware and lamps, to purely decorative pieces.

Exhibitors will include well-established names returning to the Geffrye and new talents, selected by a panel of judges comprising Marina Vaizey, former art critic for *The Times*; Karen Bunting, Ceramicist; Christine Lalumia, Deputy Director of the Geffrye Museum; and Annabelle Campbell, Assistant Curator, Geffrye Museum.

Visitors will have the opportunity not just to browse and buy, but also to talk to the makers themselves and watch free demonstrations. Special craft activities will be run to entertain children throughout Saturday and Sunday.

Ceramics in the City has been organised by the Geffrye Museum and ceramicist Karen Bunting, and supported by Mazorca Projects.
