

## Session information

Sessions last around **60 minutes** and can usually be scheduled around your school timetable.

- The earliest session start time is **10am**.
- Access to the classroom is required 30 mins before to set-up.
- Each session is for one class (30 max pupils).
- We can deliver the same session up to three times a day.

For schools in the London Boroughs of Hackney, Tower Hamlets and Islington:

1 session: £120

2 sessions repeated on the same day: £160

3 sessions repeated on the same day: £200

For other London schools up to and including Zone 4 an additional travel charge of £30 will apply.
