The Geffrye Museum can come to your classroom and deliver:

One-off Sessions

Our one-off outreach sessions allow children to handle objects found in the home over the last 400 years and can be used to support classroom based learning across the curriculum at all key stages

For schools in Hackney, Tower Hamlets and Islington:

1 session: £120

2 sessions on the same day: £160

3 sessions on the same day: £200
