

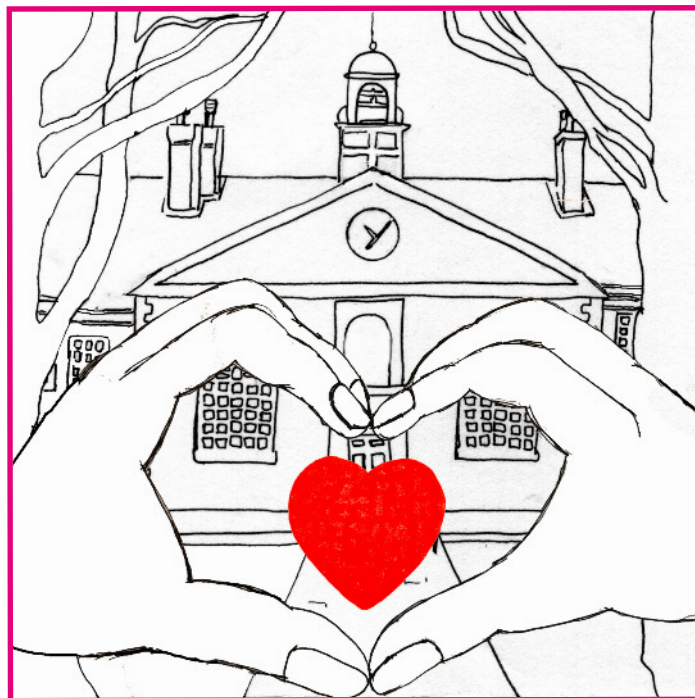
# Summer Holiday Activities: Acts of Kindness

Thursdays and Fridays 15 - 30 August, 10am - 4.30pm

At the Geffrye Museum of the Home, it really is cool to be kind. Discover fun, creative ways to spread a little love at home with your family, in the garden with nature and in the community with our friends and neighbours. Introduce young children to the kind red hen and the good giant, create an interactive bingo game for your family, take a tour of the Geffrye Almshouses or film and edit a video meme.



The museum, displays and café are currently closed for re-development but our front gardens are open for the holidays. Family activities will take place outside in the front garden under a tent unless otherwise stated. Please come prepared for all weather. A range of drinks and light snacks will be available to buy.



Holiday activities are for children aged 2-12 and are free for individuals and their families. Places for booked workshops are allocated at the museum on a first-come, first-served basis 30 minutes prior to the beginning of each activity. All children under 11 must be accompanied by an adult at all times. All activities are accessible for families with additional needs.
